The Makerspace Program provides financial and technical assistance to entities seeking to establish and expand a Makerspace.

WHO

Entities currently operating or seeking to operate a Makerspace in the State of Maryland who are either a local government, an agency or instrumentality designated by the local government, or a nonprofit.
